


Installing the QGIS NAFI plug-in


QGIS is a free mapping software program you can download from www.qgis.org This program allows you to create your own maps by combining map information from different sources, like the NAFI fire data or your own fence line, track or site maps. These maps can then be used for planning or reviewing your fire management.

While you know where your own maps are, it can often be difficult tracking down maps from other places like the NAFI fire data, so to make it easier to find all the NAFI data nicely organised for use in your QGIS map program, we have made it a QGIS "plug-in". To install the plugin, firstly download QGIS from www.qgis.org and then follow the steps below.


1. Find the NAFI plug-in. IN QGIS, select the "Plugins" menu at the top and select "Manage and Install Plugins" from the drop-down.




The search box for all the plug-ins should appear, and in the top search bar, type "NAFI":



You should then see the NAFI plug-in displayed in the list of plug-ins – select the plug-in and you'll see the details in the right-hand panel.



2. Install the NAFI plug-in. Click the "Install Plugin" button at the bottom right and the NAFI plug-in should install. You should see a new bar appear with a "NAFI" button displayed. Clicking on this will download all the NAFI layers to QGIS.



You can now open the folders and select the NAFI layers for display in QGIS.
